AGC Responsible Together Commitment

We are excited to travel with you soon! Whether this is your first AGC trip or your 20th trip, we are thankful you've chosen us for your next adventure. The well-being of our community of travelers, guides, locals hosts and partners remains our priority. In light of COVID-19, our trips will be a little different and before joining us, we want you to clearly understand the changes in our policies and programming, and importantly, your responsibilities and commitment to our collective well-being. Importantly, in choosing to participate, each of you must carefully review and sign a [Supplemental COVID](#) Addendum to the [AGC: Acknowledgment and Assumption of Risks & Release and Indemnity Agreement](#).

As you're aware, COVID-19 is a serious virus with potentially life-threatening consequences and AGC cannot guarantee a COVID-19 free environment. The risk of contracting COVID-19 or any other communicable or contagious disease is an inherent risk of social exposure and travel. As AGC continues in its endeavor to manage risks, including those associated with COVID-19, we recognize that our participants are critical partners in this effort.

Our risk management and emergency response plans include heightened procedures and policies in various facets of our trips. We have made these changes in consultation with our guides, the Adventure Travel Trade Association, and local authorities. It is important that you respect and abide by these policies and procedures. Some of these policies we will plan and prepare for. In other cases, we will remain vigilant about the information we receive and may amend these policies, as appropriate, or as required by authorities. We believe in our ability to operate AGC trips in a manner that aligns with relevant US (federal, state or county) or international guidelines, CDC recommendations and our own policies, as we endeavor to manage for COVID-19, and hopefully prevent its spread.

Key to our success will be our partnership with our participants. The risks of COVID-19 transmission to anyone, including you, can occur both in the AGC trip community and in your home community as you move into, and then out of AGC trips – with your actions potentially impacting both communities. As a result, participants share in the responsibility for their own and others' well-being. In that regard, we ask that you make a commitment to honor the COVID-19 precautions not only when you are on an AGC trip, but, appropriately, before you arrive and after you depart. You are then partnering as an active risk manager in an effort to assist both communities.

Despite the changes to our programming, we are determined to provide a fulfilling experience for all, with your cooperation. Before arriving on an AGC trip, we will orient you around COVID-19 (and other) precautions and policies, so all participants are clear on their role in the risk management equation regarding COVID-19 and other aspects of the trip - and reinforce this commitment.

***An important reminder:** Per our COVID-19 policies, we ask that you practice social distancing, wear a mask as required, avoid large gatherings and follow applicable COVID-19 guidance in the 14 days before the trip start date. We ask you to disclose to us before the trip starts, whether or not, within that time, you have exhibited any COVID-19 or flu-like symptoms or been exposed to anyone known to have COVID-19. We appreciate your cooperation here.

We will work to maintain open lines of communication with you, and will be updating you on AGC COVID trip policies before your arrival and upon arrival. Please contact us if you have questions.
